

Dear member of the university community,

Hereby the University administration informs You, that according to the decision of the Board of Directors no.4/5 of 19.03.2015, which is based on the Order of the Rector no.314-A of 12.10.2010 on smoking ban in university premises, National Programme on Tobacco Control for the years 2012-2016, provisions of the Framework Convention of the World Health Organization on Tobacco Control, ratified by Law no.124-XVI of 11.05.2007, The University Charter (art. 32,48,93), Internal Regulations of the University (art. 7.4) - **smoking is banned in the university premises**, that include all buildings: blocks of studies, clinics, hospitals, centres, hostels, buildings, structures, premises of any kind and any destination, lands, engineering constructions, libraries, reading rooms, laboratories, canteens, pharmacies, workshops, gyms, resorts used by the University, including the adjacent to listed buildings territories.

All members of the university community are asked to comply with the University Smoke-free Policy, especially as they assumed this obligation by signing individual labor contract (art. 5.1) - valid for employees, and contract for studies – valid for students, residents, clinical interns, master students, doctoral candidates, trainees, etc.

We also inform You that, by the order of the rector no. 124-A of 12.04.2016, the Commission for monitoring of smoking was established in the University. People that will be detected by video and / or photo, minutes of observation, confirming the place, date and hour of violations committed, will be invited to explain their behavior before the Commission.

Commission for monitoring of smoking is empowered to examine each case and to submit proposals to the University administration on the application of sanctions (reprimand, severe reprimand, or, even, dismissal for an employee, expelling for a student, resident ) to person that has violated the provisions of the Nicolae Testemitanu SUMPh Smoke-free Policy.
