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Regarding the activity of the University
starting with October 12, 2021

In accordance with the provisions of the Decision of the Extraordinary National Commission for Public Health no. 63 of October 8, 2021, Order of the Minister of Education and Research no. 1170 of 24.08.2021 on the organization of the educational process in educational institutions, in order to ensure the security of health and life of beneficiaries and employees of the University,

ORDER:

1. Starting with October 12, 2021, the activity of the University will be carried out with the physical presence in all subdivisions with strict observance of the precautionary measures in force, according to the instructions approved by the decisions of the Extraordinary National Commission of Public Health. Responsible: vice-rectors, deans of faculties and heads of subdivisions.
2. To continue and carry out the educational process according to the schedule drawn up for the autumn semester, a.y. 2021-2022 starting with October 12, 2021 for all years of all study programs as follows:
 - 2.1. seminars, practical and laboratory works, modular assessments for the compulsory disciplines will be held out with the physical presence;
 - 2.2. on-line will be held: lectures in all compulsory disciplines; all forms of training in optional and free choice disciplines (lectures, practical works, seminars, assessments); recoveries and tutorials, including those on graduation theses; all teaching activities in the discipline "Disaster Medicine". Responsible: vice-rectors, deans of faculties and heads of subdivisions.
3. To ensure the observance of the prophylaxis measures for the spread of COVID-19 infection, by the university community. Responsible: heads of subdivisions, the entire university community.
4. To provide regular information to students, doctoral students and resident physicians on prevention measures, clinical manifestations and early diagnosis of SARS CoV-2 virus infection, with the recommendation of isolation at home in case of symptoms of respiratory diseases and immediate contacting of the family doctor. Responsible: deans of faculties and heads of teaching subdivisions.
5. To ensure the presentation by all employees of the University of the following documents:
 - vaccination certificate against COVID-19 with complete vaccination schedule (with any authorized vaccine type), or
 - medical conclusion confirming that the person underwent COVID-19 between the 15th and 180th day (6 months), or
 - confirmation of the presence of anti-COVID-19 antibodies, valid for 90 days from the date of the investigation, or

- the result of a diagnostic test for COVID-19 (rapid diagnostic test for AgSarsC-oV-2 or PCR test for COVID-19) which is valid for 14 days from the date of the investigation. Responsible: V.Revenco, vice-rector for clinical activity and residency, L.Mazur-Nicorici, head of the Clinical Activity Management Center and heads of Subdivisions.
- 6. To ensure the permanent monitoring and immediate information of the University administration about the occurrence of COVID-19 infection, as well as to inform weekly, until Friday, 10.00, the Ministry of Education and Research on the number of COVID-19 infection registered in the institution and the vaccination rate of university staff. Responsible: Valeriu Revenco, vice-rector for clinical activity and residency, Lucia Mazur-Nicorici, head of the Clinical Activity Management Center.
- 7. To monitor the observance by the hostel residents of the measures to prevent the transmission of COVID-19 in the University hostels. Responsible: Marcel Abras, vice-rector for social issues; Victor Schiopu, director of the Student Campus; hostel administrators.
- 8. To ensure the activity of the University Food Complex, with the observance of the obligatory public health measures with the use of not more than 50 percent of the existing number of places, with the obligation of all persons to present the COVID-19 certificate to the responsible person, when entering the University Food Complex. Responsible: Marcel Abras, vice-rector for social issues; Rodica Iachim, head of the University Food Complex.
- 9. To ensure the restriction of the access to the teaching blocks for people who do not belong to University community. Responsible: Valentina Spac, head of the Heritage Administration Department, administrators of teaching blocks.
- 10. To ensure the continuing provision of study blocks and dormitories with hand and surface disinfectants for compliance with epidemiological prophylaxis measures, including ensuring the sanitation of all common areas with authorized disinfectant solutions, as well as the frequent ventilation of rooms. Responsible: Marcel Abras, vice-rector for social issues; Victoria Cravet, vice-rector for economic and financial activity, Valentina Spac, head of the Heritage Administration Department, Victor Schiopu, director of the Student Campus; heads of subdivisions, hostel administrators.
- 11. To inform the university community about the provisions of this order. Responsible: Silvia Ciubrei, Head of Communication and Public Relations Department.
- 12. The execution of this order is assigned to vice-rectors (Olga Cernetchi, first vice-rector, vice-rector for academic activity, Stanislav Groppa, vice-rector for research, Valeriu Revenco, vice-rector for clinical activity and residency, Marcel Abras, vice-rector for social issues, Victoria Cravet, vice-rector for economic and financial activity).
- 13. I assume the control of the execution of this order.
